I heartfully thank you for the care and prayers for me during the time I was arrested and put into prison (August 3rd, 2007) for receiving a quantity shipment of The Bible. And I thank you for the love and the help you offered for my family. I'm proud of you. It also reminds me of something Lord Jesus says, "For I was hungry and you gave me

something to eat, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, ... I was in prison and you came to visit me ... I tell you the truth, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers of mine, you did for me."



According to the decision of the Shayibake District People's Procuratorate of Urumqi city, Xinjiang China, I was declared not guilty, released from Xishan Penitentiary in February 19, and regained my freedom. I am now recuperating at home. Although I am still physically weak, my heart is filled with peace and light from the Holy Spirit. Let us, in Christ, continue to focus on Father's

kingdom and righteousness. Let us thank, praise and worship the great, almighty and loving God. Romans 8:26-30
